The gameplay is rhythm-based, which means you have to jump and fly past obstacles. If you're using a mobile device, you can tap the screen to move past obstacles. Otherwise, you'll have to utilize the up key, down key, spacebar key, and left-click on your keyboard and mouse to control the character. Most of the levels contain geometrical graphics. That's why the game is called "Geometry Dash". All the rewards, obstacles, player icons, and background visuals are made up of different shapes, such as triangles, squares, circles, and rectangles. When you slide and crash into something, the effects resemble cubes. The second word of the game's title, "Dash", is attributed to its fast-paced gameplay. You're forced to maneuver past obstacles by jumping and flying through them at top speeds. If you keep your finger on the up key or spacebar key on the keyboard, it'll allow you to do a multi-jump to move further in the level. It started being sold for \$2.00 USD on August 13 2013, and is a 2D platform game that involves dodging obstacles (spikes, walls, and creatures) in a series of levels. Players can create levels in the level editor, and play levels made by other players. There are many tools for creating levels: rings (commonly just called orbs), pads that boost you up higher, and triggers that allow the level creator t "The player moves towards the right of the screen automatically in the game's classic mode, whereas the player has full control of their movement in platformer mode (released in the latest update, 2.2). There are gamemodes that the player can turn into: Ship, Ball, UFO, Wave, Robot, Spider, and Swing. All of these gamemodes have unique physics, and their own customizable icons! Geometry Dash is available on Steam and Mobile. The player can use the keyboard, touch screen, controller, mouse, etc. to control the icon. Unlocking new icons requires collecting each of the games different currencies, and can be done by completing quests, lists and certain levels (daily, weekly, gauntlet) for diamonds, completing map packs and official levels for secret coins (or star rated levels for user coins) and star rated / official levels for stars (with platformer levels rewarding moons instead). Beating or progressing any star rated level also grant mana orbs (a feature introduced in update 2.1).
