You can use Google Store Financing to buy things in the Google Store in the US if you want to. The financing will be provided by Synchrony Bank. You can view your returns as the difference between current value and reported cost basis. Additionally, you can view your portfolio highlights, which include allocation metrics and a suggested comparison to other assets. To compare your portfolio to other assets, use time-weighted rate of return, which adjusts for cash inflows and outflows. You can select a suggested comparison or click Compare to search for a specific asset.
