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## My baby has a lump behind her ear

Parents often worry about lumps and bumps on the head of a child unnecessarily. Children normally have soft crests and spots on the head for a while after birth. Many have a type of swollen gland that parents can feel when they rub their heads. All this is normal. Anatomy of the skull Start with a brief overview of the head of a child. We were born with many bones in our skull. This allows the head to be squeezed from the birth channel while the bone plates move together or overlap each other. The bones of the infantile skull sometimes do not notice much with these bones, but sometimes overlap each other evident after birth. When a child has a lot of head distortion due to the overlap of the bones of the skull, we call it molding. It can make the head look sharp - which is often called cone head. Soft spot There are 1-2 â€“Spot soft” at birth. Usually the one at the top of the head (the front fountain) remains open enough to feel for the first 18-24 months of life. That towards the back of the head (the back fountain) is not able to be felt about 2 months of age. Often it is so small at birth that it is not recognized. Many parents fear that touching a weak point will somehow damage the child's brain. The normal touch didn't hurt, even from a 2-year-old brother. There are several layers of skin and other tissues that protect the brain. Doctors will feel soft spots during routine checks to make sure they are the right size for the growth of the child's head. There are a lot of variation here, so if you question the size of your baby's soft spot, discuss it in a visit with your doctor. He or she will have to not only feel the soft point, but will also look at the general growth of the head, the development of the child and the shape of the head. The bruises and bleeding coming out of the birth can be traumatic for both the mother and the child (and often for the fathers). Sometimes children have a big soft or soft bump on one side of the head, which is usually a large bruise. The bruises can cause ittero yellow. Any bruise can increase the risk of jaundice in a newborn, so your doctor may look at your child more carefully for this in the time when the blood is reabsorbed. It develops from the bleeding of a layer over the periostium in the skin. It can cross bone areas as it is not limited by bone coating (periosteum). You will notice a soft and inflated swelling on the scalp of the child, usually in the area that came out during childbirth. Some will show bruises. Both of these conditions can lead to an increase in the risk of yellow jaundice due to the distribution of blood collections, but usually self-resolve without complications. If the child seems uncomfortable due to this area, discuss with the nurse or doctor of the hospital. The following figure tries to show the bleeding layers described here and includes the rarest bleeding types (and more worrying). Children who have a deep bleeding need adequate medical care. Flat stains are common, especially if newborns prefer to always look on one side. This can cause the forehead to appear as swelling on one side or ear to appear closer to the face than the other ear. This is usually due to the child who puts in a direction most of the time, allowing the brain to grow in all directions, but the child spot is laying on. Children must always sleep on their back until they start rolling alone, but this can encourage a flat head. It's important to lay the child on the right sometimes, on the left sometimes. The supervised belly time is also useful. I recommend starting the belly time on the first day. First you start your belly time less seem to hate it!
