Your pulled-apart tie will have a layer of interfacing inside. Whether you're a seasoned crafter or a beginner looking to try something new, making your own ties is a great way to unleash your creativity and add a personal touch to your wardrobe. Blank printable tie template Coloured cardstock Scissors Glue Rainbow Ink Pad (optional) We have included a blank tie template for you to print out, you can find it by scrolling down below. You can easily adjust the pattern for your perfect size. For the interlining, it is usually cut the same size as the main fabric. Do the folded edges have a personality of their own? If, of course, does use more fabric than just cutting it from the straight grain. PATTERN or OLD TIE - Use an old tie you like the shape of to make your own pattern or print the pattern included in this tutorial. Put the 2 main pieces together and stitch with a ½ inch (12mm) seam allowance. All images are copyrighted. A slip stitch is the easiest to use, and if you use a matching color thread, it will blend into the seam. You can then glue your buttons on top. Press one edge over the other so they overlap in the center. On the wrong side, press the edges over by ½ inch (12mm) Overlap the folded edges by ¼" (6mm) in the center. This is in order to make them drape better and softer. Instead, use pattern weights or cans from your pantry to hold down the pattern. Don't worry if your lining fabric frays a little as the top raw edge will be hidden later when it is sewn down the middle. Personalize the tie even further with learning how to embroider letters or applique. These printable tie templates and tie outlines are perfect for all your crafting needs. Kids can color, glue, or write on the outside and inside of the card before giving it to Dad! You are free to use these templates for personal use at home or in the classroom. Please don't share the file, but if you'd like to share the necktie outlines with friends, please forward this page to them so that they can download the file themselves. Unfortunately, there is no good way to sew this seam with a sewing machine and have it lie completely flat. Otherwise, just sticky tape a few printer paper pieces together to get the length. Stitch the sides and bottom v shape leaving the top open. Have you ever wondered if your kid could tie their own bow tie and necktie with ease? TIE SIZE: This tie pattern results in a tie 3.5 inches across at bottom with a length of 56 inches. Children can decide how they want to decorate their tie template. These templates are in an easy to download and print PDF format. These seams are usually cut at an angle. A sharp pair of scissors should be used or a rotary cutter. Take note that the pieces need to be cut on the bias (45 degree angle) so the tie fabric has some stretch and increased drape. They vary a lot in shape and length, so if you don't have one to copy, try your local discount store or second-hand store. You will work slip stitch from right to left. Whether you're crafting with kids, planning a themed party, or simply looking for a unique project, our tie templates will inspire endless creativity. Push the needle back into the fold and move it along the fold about ¼ inch (6mm) Pull the thread and repeat. That's not all, though! The front of the tie turns into their own little design playground, which they may decorate with any little, glittery objects, making their own different styles. The copyright remains with the respective creators. Bring the needle up from underneath the fold so the knot is hidden. Insert the needle in the top fold. Then write your message inside the outline and erase the pencil markings when you're done. How to Slip Stitch When Sewing a Tie: Thread a needle with a double thread and knot the end. To download, simply click on the image of the template you want and it will download to your device. Hand stitch the folded edge along its length. Anything goes on the back of the tie. Put the 2 tie pieces with right sides together and sew the straight ends with a ½ inch (12mm) seam allowance. Press the edges over by ½ inch (12mm). The fun is just getting started! Great Gift for Dad Are you ready to see the excitement as your children give a token of their creativity and love? It is important to make the guideline on your new pattern pieces. You will be cutting the pieces on the diagonal (bias) of the fabric in order to make the tie sit and drape well.
