Demographic information is collected and inferred based on a respondents browsing history. The algorithm is the same method Google uses for advertising targeting, and uses signals to determine demographics such as gender and age. Can I target my questions to a particular group? Yes, there are two different ways to target respondents: Choose one of the demographic or geographic buckets. Ask a preliminary screening question, for example, Are you a small business owner?, and provide non-binary answers such as Yes, I own a small business. No, but I manage a small business.
