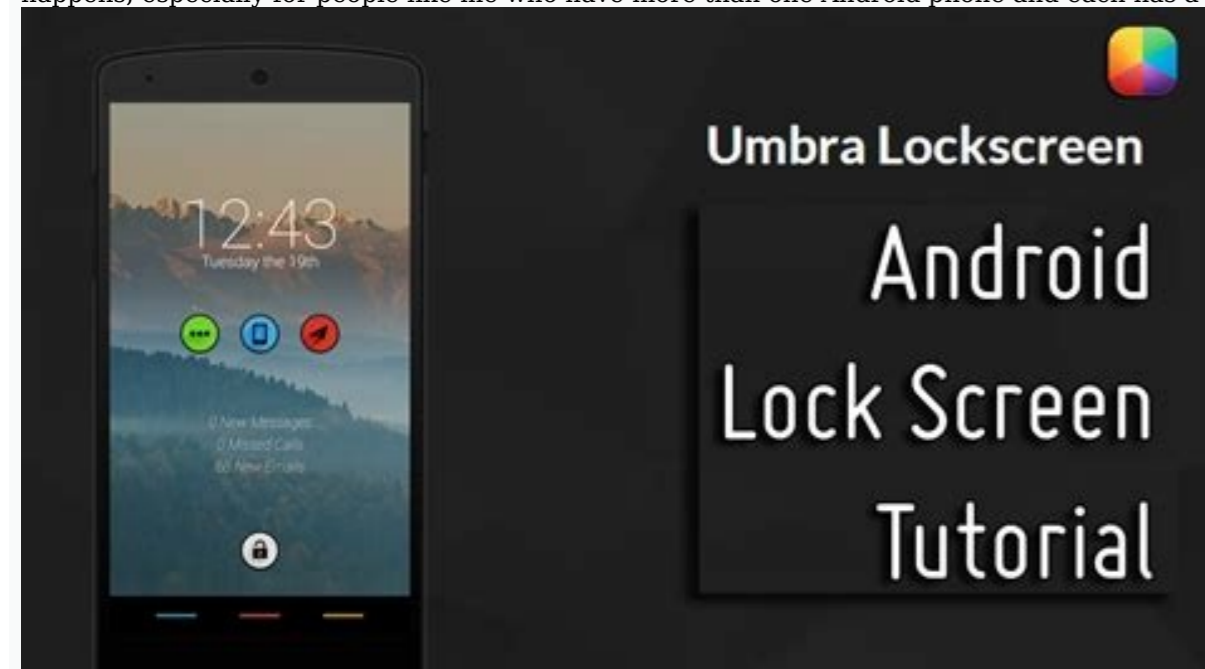
On some Android devices, security and location are called security and privacy. Confirm your current PIN, password or combination if you have one. Then choose Swipe, PAT, PIN or Password. Under Security and location settings, tap Screen lock settings. Touch the lock screen and choose one of three options: Show all sensitive content.



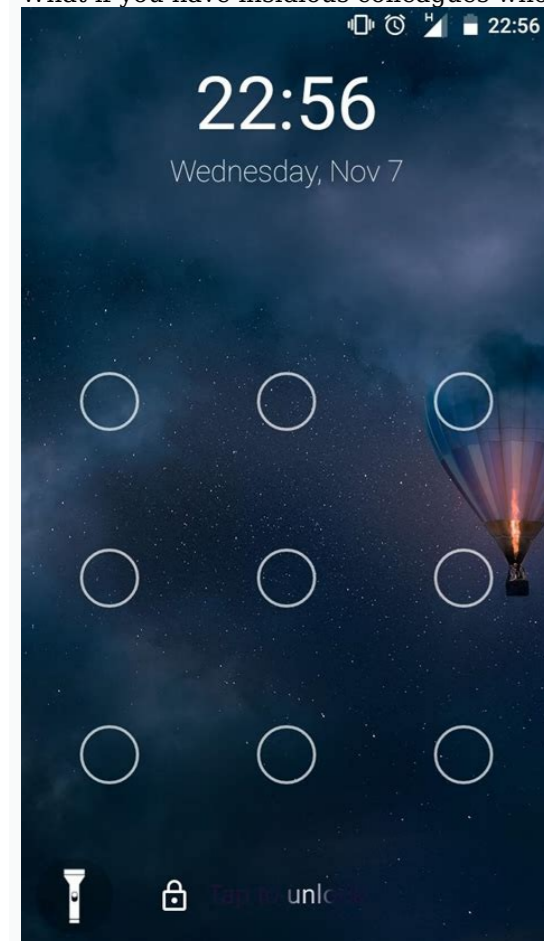
Hide sensitive content. Notifications don't show any other text at all until you unlock it. Go to Lock screen settings > Lock screen message to add text to your lock screen, e.g. B. Contact information if the phone is lost. If your smartphone has a fingerprint scanner, use it to unlock the device. Depending on your device, you may be able to add more than one fingerprint, allowing even trusted people to unlock your phone. Enabling Google Find My Device (formerly Android Device Manager) is a smart move. If your phone is lost or stolen, you can find it, call it, lock it, or reset it. Go to settings. This type of program offers alternative ways to lock and unlock the phone, display messages and adjust background pictures and patterns. Only Locker can use your photos as an access code and you can create a lock screen interface. From top to bottom, you can repair layers, such as dressing to push through a frozen tundra in Canadian spam in winter. One of the outer layers is the cause (or pin) of the screen block. With this model, you can set a fairly strong protection that may prevent unwanted users from accessing your data. But what if you forget this model? Believe me, this happens, especially for people like me who have more than one Android phone and each has a different model.



What if you have insidious colleagues who set a security model without your knowledge? How to access this phone?



Fortunately, the creators of the Android platform have just thought about it.

I will discuss two main ways of restoring the Android screen lock model. The first way: Use Android certificates if your mobile phone still operates on the 4.4 or older version of Android, follow these steps to avoid the Android screen lock template when you get stuck. [oi simpson if i did it charlie](#) Step 1: Press the "Power" button on your Android device to turn on the screen lock and enter your pattern. Some phones require you to move the lock screen to the right before getting into the correct lock pattern (see Figure A). Figure A: Some headsets jump right into the lock screen formula, while others require a sliding screen first.

Step 2: If you draw the wrong formula five times, you will be warned that you failed when you unlock your phone and try again in 30 seconds. However, you can also turn on the alarm connection with the screen lock by pressing the alarm connection button (see Figure B). Figure B: Alarm connection button. Step 3: Try to go back to the lock pattern before it expires in 30 seconds, and look for a new button in the lower right corner of the lock screen (see Figure C). Figure C: The timer tells you how much time you have before you can try again. If you don't remember the formula, don't wait. Step 4: Click on Forgotten Samples and you will be asked to provide the login details for the Google account on the device (see Figure D). Figure D: Without login information, you need to hard reset your phone. [14523307500.pdf](#) Step 5: After successfully verifying your phone account, you will be asked to create a new unlock pattern (see Figure E). Figure E: Draw the formula, click Continue, draw the formula again, and go back to your business.

Second: Reset your Android phone using the new Android version buttons, you may see the option to forget the pattern when you try to reset the pattern from the lock screen. Fortunately, you can use the power and volume buttons to reset Android. Note. This option deletes all data stored on the device, such as applications, contacts, music, and photos. However, if you verified this data in your Google account, you can restore it later: Step 1: Securityphone is turned off. Step 2: Press and hold the Power and Volume Down buttons simultaneously until the screen turns on. Step 3: When the screen turns on, use the Volume Up and Power buttons to navigate and select the Recovery Mode option. Step 4: After selecting the recovery mode option, go to Wipe data / Factory reset and select the option using the power button.

Step 5: Wait for the factory reset to complete. Once this is done, Android will automatically reboot to its default settings. Currently, you can set a new screen lock pattern and restore backup data in settings. Enhanced security You can also increase the security of your phone by setting it to lock as soon as you press the power button and turn off the screen. Most devices have a default safety time of two minutes. This means you can turn off the screen and return to your phone without entering a pattern before the timer expires. In some cases, this may pose a security risk.
