Using DAX to Color Table Rows Based on Slicer Filters I am new to DAX and need help coloring the background of a table row based on a specific condition in Power BI. Is there an easy way, when I click on the clear all slicer button, all filters are reset except for the date slicer? I have created a Power Automate flow and attached a screenshot for reference. I need help determining which CSV parser to use in the File Content action to read data from a file. A simple question, but one that has stumped me online - I'm new to Power Apps. What I'd like to achieve is clicking a button and clearing all fields (inputText, checkbox, etc) from a gallery. Here's my scenario: My data source is an Excel table; this gallery doesn't use collections or forms, just displaying information from the 'tab_list' section of my data source. I attempted the following command without success: Mybutton OnSelect ForAll(BrowseGallery1.AllItems; If(ThisRecord.Checkbox1.Value = true;Checkbox1.Value = false); ThisRecord.InputText1.Text = "")
