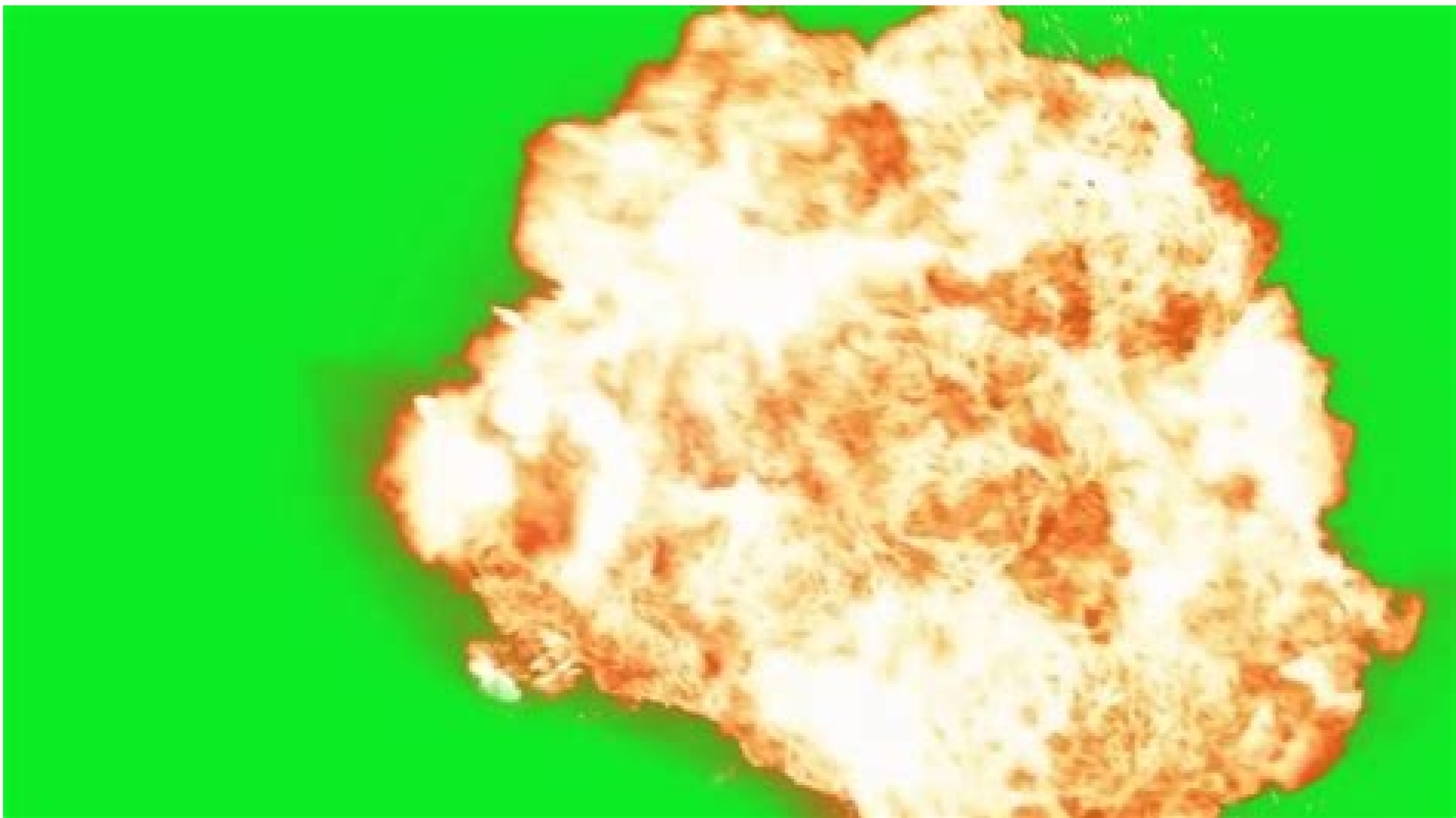

But this tool has one feature that we will be using, and that is the feature that allows you to remove codes from the pages you visit. Let me demonstrate this on a video streaming site that has too many ads. As you can see in the image above, this site is full of ads, ads that slow down page loading. But soon everything will change. Step 1: Right-click on the page and select Explore. To make things easier, right-click on one of the ads and select Inspect Item. The exact code used to display your ad will be displayed. Step 2. Find each promo code. If you don't understand the code you see, just click on the little "triangles" or "arrows" in the "Inspect Item" tool and hover over each line of code until you see the one that highlights the declaration you want to remove, as shown in the image above. Step 3: After accepting the keyword, click the Remove button. If you have selected the correct line of code, the ad will be removed from the page. If you accidentally deleted an important file and the page crashed, don't worry, just refresh the page and repeat steps 1-3.
